Day 1 – Monday – March 5: USA – Tel Aviv

Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – Tuesday – March 6:

Arrival – Jaffa – Tel Aviv

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv. You will be met and assisted by a Coral Travel & Tours representative inside the terminal. Drive to **Jaffa**, one of the oldest cities in the world. Visit the house of Simon the Tanner, and walk through Jaffa's reconstructed Old Quarter. Dinner and Overnight: Hotel in Tel-Aviv.

Day 3 – Wednesday – March 7:

Jaffa - Caesarea – Megiddo – Sea of Galilee

After a short drive through Tel Aviv, Israel's modern metropolis, travel through the Sharon plain to **Caesarea**, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. A drive up **Mt. Carmel** will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. **Falaffel Lunch**. Continue to **Megiddo**, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built again by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the **Plains of Jezreel**. On your way to Tiberias, stop at **Nazareth (Hill Top)**, where Jesus was almost thrown from the brow of the hill. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 4 – Thursday – March 8:

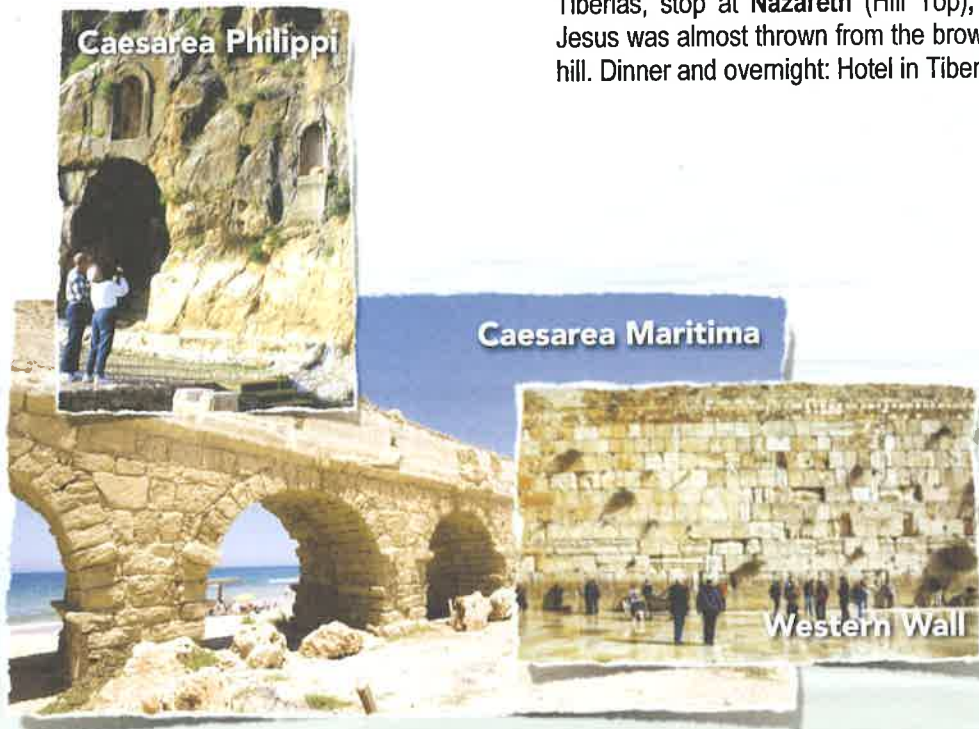
Sea of Galilee

The day starts with a boat ride on the **Sea of Galilee**. Visit **Capernaum**, the town Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. Capernaum is the place where Jesus recruited the first of His disciples (Matthew 4:13, Luke 4:31-37, Matthew 8:14-17, Mark 2:1-12, Matthew 8:5-13, Mark 5:21-43, Matthew 11:23-24). Visit the excavation of the ancient synagogue and the house of St. Peter. Continue to the "ancient boat" believed to be from Jesus' time at **Kibbutz Ginossar**. Visit the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-12). Stop at **Magdala** to see the new excavations. Visit the newly dug site of **Bethsaida**, which, according to some scriptures, is the site of the feeding of the 5000. Continue on to **Kursi**, the site of the miracle with the swine. We'll end the day at the **Jordan River** with an opportunity to be baptized. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.

Day 5 – Friday – March 9:

Golan Heights

After breakfast drive to **Tel Dan**, an important biblical city and a breathtaking nature reserve. The bible mentions the city few times: "From Dan to Beer Sheba". Continue to the **Banias**, site of the ancient **Caesarea Philippe**. For lunch you will be able to sample the **St. Peter Fish** (on our own). It is here that Peter made his confession of faith in Jesus (Matthew 16:13). Enjoy a panoramic view of the Golan Heights from **Mt. Bental**. Continue on to **Nimrod's Castle**, a medieval fortress perched high on the mountain overlooking the city of Caesarea Philippi. Drive around the city of **Qatzrin**. Return to Tiberias. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Tiberias.



Day 6 – Saturday – March 10: Bet She'an – Jericho – Dead Sea

After breakfast leave Tiberias and drive to **Bet She'an**. Recent excavations have unveiled the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 AD. Continue with a visit at **Ein Harod – Gideon Springs**. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to your hotel. Enjoy an afternoon "float" at the **Dead Sea**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel at the Dead Sea.

Day 7 – Sunday – March 11:

Massada – Ein Gedi – Qumran - Jerusalem

After breakfast take a jeep ride into the wilderness that will bring you close to **Massada**. Ascend Massada by cable car. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the ramp, and the oldest synagogue in the world. Depart Jerusalem and travel east to the shores of the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth. Continue to **Ein Gedi**, an oasis on the Dead Sea shore. Near the 200 meter high waterfall is a cave where David had his famous meeting with King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the reservation confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. Continue on to **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Drive to Jerusalem and stop at **Genesis Land** where you will enjoy a camel ride, Abraham hospitality and special dinner. Enter the city as a pilgrim. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Monday – March 12: Jerusalem

In the morning ascend the **Mount of Olives** for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday Way** and descend to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Visit the famous **Church of All Nations**. Drive along the "last way" to Mt. Zion. Walk in the **Kidron Valley** and see the Tombs of Absalom, Zachary and James. Stand next to the **Southern Wall** and view the City of David. Visit the **Church of Peter in Gallicantu**, the site where Peter denied his Lord three times. It was also the **House of the High Priest Caiphas** where Jesus was interrogated. **Shwarma Lunch**. Visit the **City of David** and **Warren's Shaft**. Continue on to **Mt. Zion** and visit the **Last Supper Room** and **King David's Tomb**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Tuesday – March 13: Jerusalem

This morning participate in an archeological dig at **Emek Zurim**. In the afternoon drive to the **Ella Valley**, where David fought Goliath. You will also visit **Latrun**, the armored museum. Return to Jerusalem. After dinner attend the **Light and Sound show** at the **David Tower museum**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Wednesday – March 14: Jerusalem

After breakfast drive to **Mt Moriah**. Visit the **Western Wall**, last remnant of the second Jewish Temple during the time of Jesus. Walk up to the Temple site and view the **Dome of the Rock** and **El Aqsa Mosque**. Visit the **Cardo** (the Jewish Quarter), the **Rabbinical Tunnel** and the **Davidson Center** (Southern Wall). Walk to the **Pool of Bethesda** and **St. Anne's Church**, a fine example of Crusader architecture. Walk through the colorful Bazaar to the Jaffa Gate. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – Thursday – March 15: Jerusalem – New City - Departure

Visit the **Israel Museum**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are displayed and the **Holy Land walk-around model** of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the Second Temple period. Continue on to **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Memorial, and experience a visit you will never forget. End your day with communion at the **Garden Tomb**. Late check out from the hotel. **Farewell dinner**. Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA.

Day 12 – Friday – March 16: Tel Aviv – USA

Your flight back to the USA departs around midnight. Arrive the same day.
